





# **Glossary**

- Channel Channels are spaces for all the team members, tools, and files you need to get work done in Slack. Channels can be created for different teams, topics, and projects.
- Direct message (DM) Direct messages are one-to-one conversations between you and another member.
- Group direct message (Group DM) Group direct
  messages are smaller discussions, outside of channels,
  between you and up to eight other members.

#### MESSAGE FIELD

- Mention (@mention) When you send a message and include an @mention, the person you mention will be notified.
- Reminders Slack allows setting reminders in order not to forget important things such as meetings, to-do items, and more.
- Slackbot Slackbot is a built-in bot in Slack.
- Huddles A voice-only conversation in a Slack channel or direct message.

### **Slack Guests**

- **Single-Channel Guest** A role in Slack that gives someone access to one channel in the workspace. This type of guest role is only available on paid plans, and they do not have access to Slack apps.
- **Multi-Channel Guest** A role in Slack that gives someone access to one or more channels in the workspace. This type of guest role is only available on paid plans. Multi-channel guests have access to Slack apps.

### **Advanced Tips**

- Star Messages Clicking the Star allows you to bookmark any important message and keep all these
  important messages in one place.
- Set Highlight Words To stay on top of important notifications without getting distracted by unrelated conversations, set your "My keywords." (Example: lunch break!)
- Add Emojis with Autocomplete Instead of clicking on the emoji icon and wasting time looking, you can use an emoji keyboard shortcut +:[character] and start typing to find what you're looking for. (Example: +:cake)
